DECEMBER MEETING PERFORMANCE NOTES

David Wright opened the evening's entertainment performing a rubber band trick called *Stairway* by Marcus Eddy. Two rubber bands are shown and stretched between the fingers of both hands to show four long strands. A dollar bill is borrowed, folded length wise and wrapped around the bottom strand of the four-band ladder. One by one the dollar jumps from strand to strand up the ladder without any effort. The bill then jumps back down the ladder, one stand at a time. Finally, the bill jumps all the way up to the top strand of the ladder just like magic. (cont. right box)

Dec. Performance Notes (cont.)

Lloyd Shafer next performed Hen Fetsch's *Mental Epic*, a triple prediction effect using a slate with six panels. Lloyd asked various spectators to name a word, a number and any card. He then proceeded to show that he knew the outcome as his predictions matched the selected items perfectly.

Dale Lorzo performed a other mental effect using large posters with symbols of Christmas: Christmas tree, a gingerbread man, a candy cane, and a Christmas stocking. The audience eliminated three of the images and Dale showed that he could tell the future by showing his prediction, which was in plain sight all along.

Dave Fiscus closed out the evening's entertainment performing Ian Rowland's *The Lying Game*, a mentalism routine which involved two themes, telling the truth from lies, and being able to predict the choices people make. Two spectators took part in this game. Dave presented several faintly surreal statements about his own life and the spectators got to guess which ones were true and which were made up.

The first surprise was that Dave was apparently able to turn one of the spectators into an expert "human lie detector" with just a few simple crumbs of advice. Secondly, when all the results were in for both participants, Dave proved that he correctly predicted every one of the spectators' verdicts.
